## 2009 Limited Edition Poppy Table

*Available in Oak or Cherry until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009*

The #26 Poppy Table was one of the earliest pieces designed by Gustav Stickley. Produced for only a year in 1900, the design reveals the English roots of the blossoming American Arts and Crafts Movement of which Stickley would become America's founding father.

Of several table designs based on floral motifs, the Poppy Table is a collector favorite. Stickley's two page ad in House Beautiful in 1900 declared the..."motive for decoration is based on natural forms...where the legs suggest the stem of a plant while the tops reproduce the lines of an open flower"

The structure of the reissued Poppy Table has been enhanced with significant construction improvements particularly to strengthen it without detracting from its delicacy. The gentle, free form relief lines seen on the floral petals are delicately hand carved.

This design soon gave way to the more rectilinear Mission forms so popular today but upon reflection, it is heartening to include one of these early, original designs as part of the Stickley Collector Design Series.
